Application Process	 A complete application must include: Completed and signed registration form (must be signed by applicant as well as coordinator at home institution) Recent passport photo Tabular CV (in English or German) Higher education entrance qualification Certificate of enrollment or transcript of records from the home institution (in English or German) Proof of health insurance (see further information on the application form) Proof of language proficiency in German and/or English (see further information on the application form) For Erasmus+ students: learning agreement (section to be completed before coming to Hamburg) and grant agreement Document upon arrival in Germany: confirmation of Hamburg residence registration

Application Deadline	Nomination deadlines are 1 August and 1 February. The deadlines for submitting a full application are 15 August for the winter semester and 15 February for the summer semester.
